Special Issue on the 7th International Conference on Economic Philosophy Call for Propositions

The <u>Journal of Economic Methodology</u> will publish a special issue following the <u>7th International</u> <u>Conference on Economic Philosophy</u> held in Reims from May 28 to 31, 2024. Submissions for the special issue should (i) align with the journal's scope, though they need not pertain directly to the conference's primary theme, "Market(s) and Democracy," and (ii) be derived from presentations delivered at the aforementioned conference. We especially welcome proposals focused on issues related to economic methodology broadly understood and more generally to the philosophy of social sciences.

Submission and Procedure

Potentially interested contributors are invited to send, by email, a 1000-word proposal with a title and 3-to-5 keywords to the editors of the special issue (see below). The editors will proceed to a selection of the proposals based on their estimated quality and whether they fall into the scope of the journal. The authors of the selected proposals will then be invited to submit their full papers by a reasonable delay. The articles submitted will be evaluated according to the usual procedure of the journal.

Calendar and Guidelines

- Interested contributors must send their 1000-word proposal to the editors of the special issue. The deadline is **September 16, 2024**.
- Contributors will be informed of the editors' decision by the end of October 2024.
- Full papers will have to be submitted through the journal's platform and along the <u>instructions for authors</u>. A deadline for the submission of full articles will be announced later.
